Jesus - Is the Greek equivalent of the Hebrew word Saviour- Matt 1:21

- Refers to his humanity and incarnation by which he became a man to die for our sins.

Christ - Greek equivalent of Hebrew word Messiah (Anointed)

-Refers to Jesus as Messiah promised in the Old Testament

Anointed One- Messiah

Leviticus 4:3-5 = O.T. Priests

I Samuel 2:10, Psalms 2:2, Daniel 9:25-27

Many Different Kinds Of Anointing In The Bible

1. The Head of the guests as a token of hospitality- Psalms 23:5, Luke 7:46
2. The Head of the High Priest- empowerment, blessing- Ex 29:7, 40:13 (Symbolizes the anointing of the Holy Spirit upon the Lord Jesus)
Christ our great High Priest- Acts 4:27, 10:36, Matt 3:16
3. The Sons of Aaron- Exodus 30:30, 40:15
 - Symbolizes the Holy Spirit's anointing of Christians
 - II Chor 1:21, I John 2:27
4. On the Offerings- Ex 29:2, Lev 2:4
5. Anointing the head of the King- Isaiah 9:6; 15:1; 16:3,12; I Kings 1:34 - Symbolizes God's choice of the Man and the Holy Spirit's anointing for service.
6. To heal the sick- James 5:16
 - Symbolizes the Holy Spirit's Healing Ministry.
