Transfigure= Metamorphous - “ a change from within”

This Glory was not a reflection of an outward light; it was a presentation of an inward glory.

It is a Forview of the millennial glory of the Lord Jesus.

- III. The Glory of Christ was revealed in the Incarnation- John 1:14

- V. The Glory of Christ was ascribed by the heavenly host- Rev 5:12,
